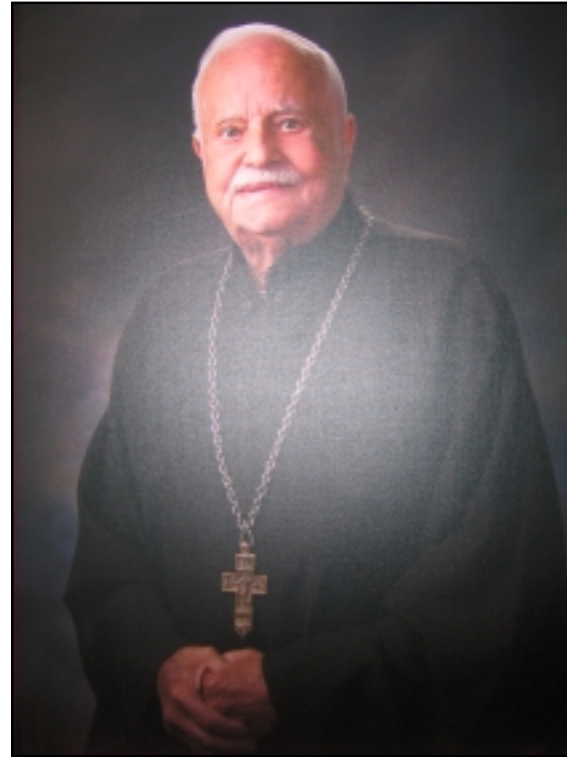

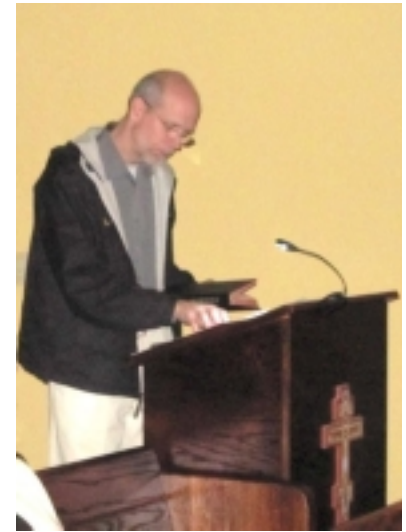
New Altar cloth for Easter will be coming our way. If you would like to make a donation towards the altar cloth, it would be greatly appreciated.

At the parish dinner Mario proudly said to Sister Anne, “My two buddies and I did the Christian thing and helped a little old lady cross the street.”

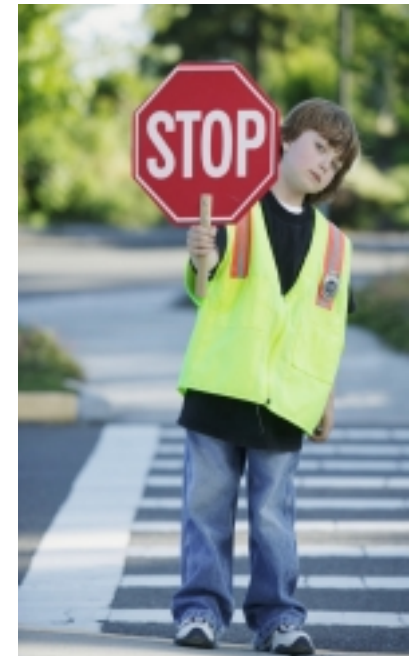

Glory to Jesus Christ!

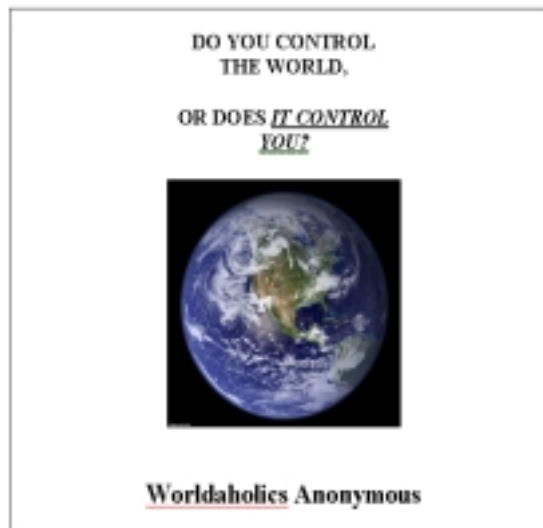
